**2006 RULES & REGULATIONS**  
*(Several Changes Apply)*

**REGION 1-C Bowling Tournament**

To be a participant in the UAW Region 1-C Bowling Tournament, you must be a member or employee from UAW Region 1-C or an immediate family member (spouse, son, son-in-law, daughter, daughter-in-law, granddaughter, grandson, grandmother, grandfather, mother, mother-in-law, father, father-in-law, brother, brother-in-law, sister, sister-in-law). A member transferred from a Region 1-C Local Union or who was a member of a closed Local, will be eligible to bowl, but you must prove that you were a member from Region 1-C.

Entrants will use the highest sanctioned (blue book) league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2004-2005 season (as of May 31st, 2005). No summer league averages will be used. The Tournament is based on a handicap basis of 80%. If you have no average from last year and are intending to use your current average at the time you bowl, you must have bowled at least 6 games and bring verification with you. PLEASE, DO NOT INSERT AN AVERAGE ON YOUR APPLICATION FORM IF YOU HAVE NO ESTABLISHED AVERAGE FROM LAST YEAR. If you have no established average, you must bowl with a 200 average.

There will be TWO DIVISIONS: MEN & WOMEN. Each division will have separate prize lists. However, a man and woman may bowl together but the woman will automatically be included on the men's prize list for the doubles event. Also, a Team can be mixed but women bowling on a mixed team will be included on the men's list only. A bowler can bowl only once in any event (Singles, Doubles or Team). If this rule is violated, the entrant will be disqualified for prizes.

Please make certain your forms are completely filled out; incomplete forms will be returned. Indicate which squad time is your first choice for Saturday. Make sure you have a Local Union Official sign your application form. TEAM CAPTAINS ONLY MAY CHECK IN FOR TEAM. ALL OTHERS MUST CHECK THE POSTED LIST FOR LANE ASSIGNMENT.

Incorrect average bowlers forfeit any rights to prizes. If a bowler has a higher average than submitted, his/her score will be disqualified. If a bowler submits an average that is too high, the score will stand on the average submitted. Any changes must be made one week prior to bowling. Absolutely no average changes after an entrant has bowled. There will be line-up changes or time changes after the tournament has started. A team will be permitted two line-up changes prior to bowling.

Preferred times will be granted whenever possible, however the Tournament Committee will assign alleys and make other Tournament decisions. If you would like to bowl near another team, include this information when submitting your entry. No lane changes will be permitted the day of the Tournament. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
