Delta Dental PPO is a national point-of-service preferred provider organization administered by Delta Dental of Michigan. You can go to any licensed dentist, but you could increase your benefits and lower your out-of-pocket costs by going to a PPO dentist. If you do not go to a PPO dentist, you will be covered by Delta Dental Premier, our carefully managed fee-for-service program. However, you might have to pay more. **If you go to a dentist who does not participate in any of Delta Dental's programs, you will be responsible for any difference between Delta Dental's payment and the amount charged by the dentist, in addition to your copayments.**

<b>CLASS I</b>				
<b>Diagnostic and Preventive Services</b> – Used to diagnose and/or prevent dental abnormalities or disease (includes exams, cleanings and fluoride treatments).	100%	0%	100%	0%
<b>Emergency Palliative Treatment</b> – Used to temporarily relieve pain.	100%	0%	100%	0%

<b>Radiographs</b> – X-rays.	100%	0%	90%	10%
<b>Relines and Repairs</b> – Relines and repairs to bridges and dentures.	100%	0%	90%	10%
<b>Minor Restorative Services</b> – Used to repair teeth damaged by disease or injury (for example, fillings).	100%	0%	90%	10%
<b>Periodontic Services</b> – Used to treat diseases of the gums and supporting structures of the teeth.	100%	0%	90%	10%
<b>Endodontic Services</b> – Used to treat teeth with diseased or damaged nerves (for example, root canals).	100%	0%	90%	10%
<b>Extractions</b> – Simple and surgical extractions.	100%	0%	90%	10%
<b>Oral Surgery Service</b> – Other surgical dental procedures, including preoperative and postoperative care.	90%	10%	90%	10%
<b>Major Restorative Services</b> – Used when teeth can't be restored with another filling material (for example, crowns).	90%	10%	90%	10%

<b>Prosthetic Services</b> – Used to replace missing natural teeth (for example, bridges and dentures).	70%	30%	50%	50%

<b>Orthodontic Services (to age 19)</b> – Used to correct malposed teeth and/or facial bones (for example, braces).	60%	40%	50%	50%
<b>Maximum Payment</b> – The annual maximum for Class I, Class II and Class III Benefits is <b>\$1,850</b> and the <b>lifetime</b> maximum for Class IV Benefits is <b>\$2,200</b> .

## How to Find a Participating Dentist

1. Delta Dental's programs are based on networks of participating dentists. Delta Dental PPO (point-of-service) gives you access to two of the nation's largest networks of participating dentists. More than 72,000 dentists throughout the United States participate in Delta Dental PPO. More than 136,000 dentists participate in Delta Dental Premier, the program that provides back-up coverage and balance billing protection outside of our PPO network.
2. You can call Delta Dental's automated telephone system, called DASI (Delta's Automated Service Inquiry), at (800) 942-0667 to get the names of PPO dentists. DASI is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
  - To use DASI most effectively, have your Social Security number available when you place the call.
  - To get the names of PPO dentists, you will be asked to enter a ZIP code. DASI will then provide a random list of PPO dentists in or near that ZIP code. You can choose between listening to the names and having a list printed and mailed to you.
  - While this system is designed to be user-friendly, please be assured that for calls placed between 8:30 a.m. and 7:50 p.m. Eastern Time, Monday through Friday, you can access a Customer Service telephone representative.
3. If you have access to the Internet, you can use the dentist directory on our Web site. You can look up the names of dentists participating in Delta Dental PPO or in Delta Dental Premier.
